Interaction with EC officials

BANGALORE, MARCH 3. The Public Affairs Centre (PAC), which claims to have detected anomalies in the voters' list, will be organising a "voters' Sabha" in the third week of March where officials of the Election Commission will interact with voters. A PAC release said the sabha was being organised to find a lasting solution to the voters' grievances. The PAC has urged aggrieved voters in Bangalore to file written reports if they had been deprived of the opportunity to vote in the recently-held Kanakapura Lok Sabha byelection.
