

Voters' lists: 'Many complaints against BMP'

BANGALORE, MARCH 29. The Public Affairs Centre (PAC), Bangalore, has reported that it has received many complaints from residents of several localities in the City that the final voters' lists have not been displayed in their areas and that they are not accessible for verification.

The BMP announced on Wednesday that the final voters' lists would be displayed at all polling stations to enable eligible voters to verify it, and report to the AROs if their names were missing. The electoral lists are to be on display at the polling stations till April 1.

The complaints received by the PAC also refer to officials not being available to answer queries from voters. The problem was that many of the polling stations used during previous elections are located in schools and colleges.

Since most educational institutions are now busy conducting annual examinations, they barred entry to the public during the exam hours.
