Citizens complain about 'Kanakapura fiasco' at meet

SEVERAL citizens complained they could not vote in the recent elections to the Kanakapura Lok Sabha constituency at a Voters' Sabha, organised by City-based NGO Public Affairs Centre here on Tuesday.

Public Affairs Centre activists, in turn, urged the aggrieved voters, for Kanakapura as well as various parts of the City, to file written complaints.

A Public Affairs Centre spokesperson said they had received 50 complaints so far, which noted that altogether 250 names were missing in the voters' list.

One of the voters, Balasubramanium said: "I went to four polling booths, but my name wasn't there in any of the booths."

Assistant Commissioner of Bangalore City Corporation Gopal Rao, who addressed the meet, said the Bangalore City Corporation had prepared an electoral list as per the direction of the Election Commission.

The new electoral list, as per the Election Commission directions, will be displayed on March 25.
